Dr. William Tayari Howard is an award-winning Broadcast Journalist celebrating his fiftieth year in San Diego radio and television. He is also a noted Philanthropist, Author, Influencer, Speaker and Entrepreneur. Accumulating over 50,000 hours on air at eight San Diego radio stations and one television station, he has written, voiced, and produced 15,000 radio, television, and public service announcements during his on-air career which began in 1970.

Dr. Howard is a graduate of Columbia School of Broadcasting in San Francisco and a Radio, Television and Film major from San Diego City College. He received an Honorary Doctorate Degree in August of 2019, and his forthcoming book debuts in 2022, entitled “Radioactive.” A United States Coast Guard Veteran serving during the Vietnam era, Dr. Howard still serves veteran’s organizations such as Wreaths across America to this day. Dr. Howard has received numerous awards including William Tayari Howard Day in the city of San Diego.
